2. CONCLUSION

The baseline assessments are clearly indicative of significant improvement in the performance of all the WUCS in general. Despite lack of adequate experience in executing civil works, the quality and progress of work executed indicates the commitment and ownership of the WUCS. The assessments are also helpful in terms of indicating areas of improvement not only to PSC but also to WUCS themselves as the assessments are done jointly with the directors and key members.
